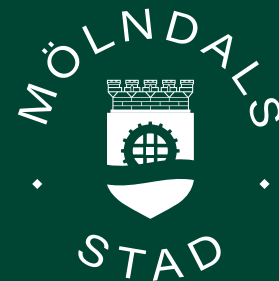


Road work in the Åbro area.



The area east of Pepparedsleden in the Åbro area is being built out in stages by developers. There will be offices, restaurants, care companies, nursing home and housing for example. For traffic safety and accessibility to all new and existing businesses in the Åbro area, the infrastructure in the area needs to be improved.

This is what we are going to do

We do the road work in stages over several years and the work that is starting now will continue until the winter of 2024. On the next page you will see a map where our various works are marked according to the numbers below.

1. We finish construction on Gemenskapens gata.
Worktime: Until december 2023.
2. On Kärragatan, we do work on pipes for water, sewage, district heating and electricity. We are also building a separate sidewalk and bike lane as well as a separate lane for right turns to the north out on Pepparedsleden. All properties are accessible from either north or south depending on where the work takes place and changes during the course of the work. Affected businesses receive separate information when this happens.
Worktime: october 2023 to april 2024.
3. We are rebuilding the circulation at the intersection of Aminogatan, Kärragatan and Pepparedsleden to improve accessibility. There will be more lanes and new pedestrian and bicycle passages. Expect this to have a major impact on traffic.
Worktime: planned april to july 2024
4. We are making the walkway and cycle lane north of the roundabout wider and expanding the car lane to two lanes up to the roundabout. Bus stop AstraZeneca "B" will get a new location a little further south. **Worktime:** Planned june to august 2024.
5. South of the roundabout, we are building a bus lane in the northbound direction on Pepparedsleden.
Worktime: Planned for august to november 2024.

Traffic impacted in the area

During our work, the traffic will be affected but it should always be possible to get around. At certain times there can be a lot of queues. This is inevitable when we build out the infrastructure, we do what we can to make the traffic flow as smoothly as possible.

The traffic can be diverted at short notice during periods and then there will be diversion signs so you can find the right way.

Bus traffic should run as usual, but keep track of your journeys in Västtrafik's app ToGo or vasttrafik.se.

Your choice of travel contribute

Travel might take more time than usual. If you have the opportunity, choose to travel sustainably to the area using, for example, public transport, bicycling or walking. You can also choose to carpool with colleagues. If you can, avoid traveling during rush hour so that those who absolutely must travel at that time can do so.

Thank you for your understanding and patience as we expand the streets for increased accessibility. The more people who choose the bike and the bus, the better the accessibility will be for those who have to take the car.
